Students graduating from the Cozad Schools shall be prepared for continuing their formal education, for entering the world of work, and for assuming their roles as responsible adult citizens. All schools in the Cozad School District have received AdvancED Accreditation. Both the Middle School and the High School are North Central Accredited. The Cozad School system is currently involved in a school improvement process.

The Cozad Community Schools received District AdvancEd Accreditation. The district has a PreK program, an after school program (AfterZone), an alternative education site, and a strong core and exploratory curriculum aligned to the Nebraska State Standards. The district offers a summer school program, available to students for additional academic assistance and credit recovery. The district has implemented one-to-one Initiative for grades K-12 providing 24/7 learning opportunities and increasing student engagement. Primary grades in elementary use iPads and grades 4-12 use Chromebooks.

Cozad is located in the center of Dawson County with deep roots in agriculture and livestock production along with a diversified business and industry base. Cozad is committed to progress and works cooperatively to provide strong infrastructure and superior quality of life features.

The population was 3,977 at the 2010 census. The town is on the Great Plains of central Nebraska, along the Union Pacific Railroad and U.S. Route 30, just north of the Platte River. The 100th meridian, which roughly marks the eastward boundary of the arid plains, passes just west of the town as is marked nearby on a prominent sign across U.S. 30. Highway 21 intersects north and south through Cozad.

Cozad's quality of life encompasses parks, museums, shopping opportunities, upto-date libraries, schools, hospital, an abundance of recreational opportunities and a culture that remains focused on creating a better future for following generations.
