DCS, in cooperation with family and community, will provide a flexible and varied educational program committed to excellence. Students will be empowered to become productive and contributing members of a global community.


The Dundy County-Stratton School District is situated in far southwest Nebraska encompassing Dundy County and the western third of Hitchcock County. Covering 1050 square miles and straddling two time zones, the district supports two elementary schools and one junior/senior high school.





The district serves approximately 360 students PK-12. In tandem with the support of their constituents, the district continues to provide a curriculum designed to meet the needs of each of the students while offering opportunities for enrichment through the varied student activities.

About as far south and west as you can go and still be in Nebraska, Benkelman is a town with a view, built on spectacular terrain featuring river views, lookouts, and ledges. Only three hours from Denver International Airport, Benkelman is located in a good hunting and fishing area. Kayakers and anglers, in particular, enjoy this area in southwest Nebraska with three lakes located within a short distance of Benkelman: Rock Creek Lake, Enders Reservoir and Swanson Reservoir. Benkelman Golf Course is a scenic 9-hole course located three miles east of Benkelman along the Republican River.
