The Scottsbluff School District's vision of the future is... to provide a safe and engaging learning environment that will empower our students of today to successfully meet the challenges of tomorrow.

Scottsbluff is located in western Nebraska between the front range of Colorado and the Black Hills of South Dakota. Scottsbluff is the largest city in the Nebraska Panhandle, and the 13th largest city in Nebraska. Scottsbluff is in the middle of everywhere with north, south, east and west access to U.S. and state highways connecting to Interstates 80 and 76. Denver, Colorado and Rapid City, South Dakota are within 200 miles of Scottsbluff.

The Scottsbluff area is commonly referred to as the "Sugar Valley" in reference to the growing and processing of sugar beets. With proximity to national historic sites and monuments, and a variety of accommodations, Scottsbluff makes a good starting point for any Northwest Nebraska journey. Take a trip to Gering and Bayard (for Scotts Bluff National Monument and Chimney Rock National Historic Site, respectively), but return to Scottsbluff to spot bison and tigers at Riverside Discovery Center, visit the grave of Mormon pioneer Rebecca Winters and enjoy a summertime farmers market and locally owned, original restaurants and shops.

The Scottsbluff Public School District serves an area of 217 square miles with a PK-12 enrollment of 3,470. There are ten educational facilities in the district, including one early childhood school, five elementary K-5 schools, one middle school (grades 6-8), one senior high (grades 9-12). Additionally, the district has a Sixpence Early Childhood program serving students ages Birth to Three and ReConnect, a drop-out prevention and retrieval program for youth aged 17-21. Scottsbluff Public Schools student are equipped with 1:1 Chromebook technology in grades 6-12 and 87% of all high school seniors graduate with college credit through the career academy program. The district has been named the 2018-19 District of Distinction and the 2016-17 Outstanding High School for Career and Technical Education. The district received the AdvancED 2018 Values Driven Award of Excellence.
