Gordon-Rushville School District covers 2,300 square miles consisting of one 9-12 high school located in Gordon, a 6-8 middle school located in Rushville and two K-5 elementary schools, including Pre-K, located in both Rushville and Gordon. Schools in the district are AdvancEd and NDE accredited. The district strives to positively impact a diverse, both geographically and economically, student population. The district offers courses through distance learning and other modes of technology in addition to the district-taught curriculum. Staff and students actively work with mentoring programs to build relationships, develop cultural awareness and promote positive choices.
