Shickley Public Schools comprises 140 square miles in area, extending into Thayer and Clay counties. The district has 165 students PK -12th grade. They are ranked Class D by the Nebraska School Activities Association. Shickley participates in an all sports cooperative with Bruning-Davenport.

Shickley's Early Learning Facility is a model of its own kind, ran by salaried teachers with early-childhood degrees and highly trained paras who structure everything done on a day-to-day basis around a creative curriculum developed through the Teaching Strategies GOLD system. The staff utilizes NDE's Step Up to Quality program (they are aiming for a top-tiered Step Five standing next year), plus the Pyramid Model. They are also DHHS-certified.



Shickley is located in Fillmore County, 15 miles southwest of Geneva, the county seat. Hastings is 50 miles north and west, York is 40 miles north and east, and Lincoln is 80 miles north and east. It is a farming community in the heart of the irrigation district. The community recently built a beautiful 50 Flags Veterans Memorial. They also have a pool, park, and a community center.
