



WEST POINT PUBLIC SCHOOLS HOME OF THE CADETS

West Point Public Schools is a C1 school and has an enrollment of approximately 750 students PreK-12. The school district includes the communities of West Point and Beemer. A modern distance-learning classroom offers classes from high schools and colleges throughout Nebraska. West Point Public Schools also has a wireless lab in each building. The district participates in a consortium called Pathways 2 Tomorrow (P2T) with six area high schools to offer career and technical education classes in a partnership with Northeast Community College.

West Point is a thriving agricultural community located in Northeast Nebraska along the Elkhorn River. The community is 30 minutes from Fremont, 45 minutes from Norfolk, and 70 minutes from Omaha. In 2017, West Point received "The Outstanding Community" distinction from the Nebraska Department of Economic Development Diplomats. Neligh Park, in West Point, provides a place to enjoy camping, a swimming pool, and volleyball courts. The Community Theatre shows movies and has theatrical productions. West Point is also home to the Nielsen Community Center, one of the finest event centers in northeast Nebraska.

Beemer has golfing at the Indian Trails Country Club. Beemer's three village parks include the Beemer Main Street Park & Gazebo, which has a gazebo and provides a place to relax and watch the Main Street activities; Beemer Children's Park, which has a playground and picnic shelter; and the Beemer Village Park, which has playground equipment, ball fields, horseshoes, tennis courts, basketball hoops, sand volleyball court and a picnic area.
