The Cambridge School Community is on a mission to prepare students as life-long learners in a supportive environment.

Cambridge Public Schools is located in SW Nebraska, 25 miles east of McCook. The district has a PK – 12 enrollment of 285 students. Academics at Cambridge can be rated excellent. The students rank high in the conference and at academic contests. 100% of Cambridge students take the ACT, over 50% are enrolled in advanced courses, and 100% of students are enrolled in core subjects. An estimated 85% of graduates have gone on to higher education. Nearly 60% of these students will graduate from an institute of higher learning. Nearly 80% of our student body is participating in a traditionally positive and strong athletic program. Over 40% of the students participate in a successful music program. Many of the students are in Student Council, FCCLA, FBLA, FFA, National Honor Society, and Quiz Bowl/ Academic Decathlon. Parent participation is strong with 80% attendance at parentteacher conferences and a successful school foundation.

The progressive city of Cambridge is abundant with modern enterprise. Cambridge is home to top-notch health-care facilities, senior housing, five churches, a lively array of restaurants, excellent recreational facilities including fishing and hunting, and an 18-hole golfers' paradise.
