The mission of Osmond Community Schools is to provide all students a quality education, with its focus on academics and character, empowering them to be productive citizens of a dynamic, global society. Located 30 miles from Norfolk in northeast Nebraska, the hardworking, fun-loving citizens of Osmond welcome you to their community. With a population of around 850, Osmond lies in the heart of irrigation country and has been known as the “Water Capital of Nebraska”. Osmond offers a new swimming pool and large park in town, along with camping, boating, golf, and shopping not far away.

Osmond Community Schools has a K–12 enrollment of 170 students. The district offers a low teacher student ratio with an emphasis on community. The district embraces technology and its integration throughout the K-12 curriculum. All students have access to a device. Grades K-3 have access to iPads for all students, while grades 4-12 utilize Chromebooks. Grades 7-12 have 24/7 access to their Chromebooks and Google classwork.

Osmond Community Schools offers traditional courses, as well as courses intended to jump start students for career or college including CAD Design and Advanced CAD, Medical Terminology, Agri-Business, Business Law, Web Design, Construction Systems, Manufacturing Systems, Transportation Systems, and Dual Credit English. Offerings also include choir, band, art, business, FCS, industrial arts, foreign language and media.

Athletics offered include football, volleyball, basketball, wrestling, golf, track and field and cross country. In order to provide a variety of extracurricular activities for students, Osmond Community Schools entered into a coop with neighboring district Randolph Public Schools for some extracurricular activities. The coop mascot is the Hawks.
