Elm Creek is a PK-12 district located off I-80, 20 miles west of Kearney. Elm Creek is a tight-knit community that has a lot of pride, and is a great place to raise a family. The parents in Elm Creek are very involved and committed to their kids' activities and goals. The community has a great park complete with a newly rebuilt swimming pool and baseball fields.

A new PK-6 elementary school opened October of 2023, and the 7-12 school was built in 2010. The district maintains small class sizes and offers a robust curriculum with courses in Agriculture, Business, Technology, Health Sciences as well as the traditional classes in the areas of Math, Language Arts, Science and Social Science. The school also offers Band, Chorus, Speech and One Act, Fine Arts programs, and Athletics in the Fort Kearny Conference.

Elm Creek Schools offers dual-credit college courses, ranging from Chemistry and English Composition to Spreadsheets and Sales Communication. The district also has an agreement with the Nebraska College of Technical Agriculture allowing students to earn college credits culminating in a Diversified Agriculture Certificate.

The last weekend in August, Elm Creek celebrates Buffalo Stampede Days which brings in thousands of people to participate in the weekend's events, including a parade and fireworks, softball, volleyball, dodgeball, and horseshoe tournaments, outhouse races, a popular Show and Shine car show, mud drag races, many food venues, a BBQ cook-off, and street dance.
