Sutherland Public School has a PK-12 student population of 330 students in a district that encompasses 257 square miles. The district provides a comprehensive program of instruction, supplemented by a wide range of co-curricular activities. The Sutherland Public High School has initiated the 1-to-1 program. All students in grades 4-12 are issued lap-top computers. The curriculum at Sutherland Public School is written and aligned with Nebraska's State Standards. The district has created a model of instruction that guides staff development. Sutherland Public Schools opened an in-house daycare for staff and community in the Summer of 2023.



Sutherland is a progressive community of approximately 1,200 people located 20 miles west of North Platte. The area is rich with recreational opportunities including Sutherland Reservoir, plentiful hunting and fishing, a golf course, trap shooting, pool leagues and a pickleball league. The community also has a swimming pool and a library. The patrons of Sutherland can participate in Lion's Club, PTO, Booster Club, Chamber of Commerce, Bible Study Groups, Youth Activity Boards, Community Youth Groups and Public Service Boards.
