It is one of the older towns in the area dating back to 1884. The economic base of the community is agricultural with very little industry. Because of that fact, the population has changed very little since 1900. The district currently covers nearly 400 square miles. The school is in a cooperative agreement with Loup County Public School in Taylor for all athletic and music programs. The cooperative has the name of Twin Loup.
