

WEEPING WATER PUBLIC SCHOOLS

Weeping Water is looking for a superintendent to start July 1, 2025. The school has an enrollment of approximately 300 students. Weeping Water Public School runs on a four-day school week with students off most Mondays of the school year. Academically, the district has shown steady improvement over the past several years. The school has an early childhood program serving children ages 6 weeks to 4 years old, a middle school that allows students to experience many courses, and a career academy at the secondary level. The district offers a wide range of curriculum, and a 1-to-1 technology program integrated in the classroom. Weeping Water High school offers a comprehensive activity program for students to experience.

Weeping Water is located 40 miles southwest of Omaha and 40 miles east of Lincoln with a population of 1,100. There are many recreational offerings in the area including city lakes and park, campsites, walking trails, baseball field, and a swimming pool. The town also has a Community Center, Gibson Hall, Public Library, Airport, Community Theatre, Museum and is host to a Fall Festival, Limestone Days, and Coming Home for Christmas. The community has many groups for residents to join including Chamber of Commerce, Garden Club, American Legion, Lions Club, Mason Lodge, Eastern Star & Rainbow Girls, and the Historical Society.
