Sutton Public Schools is a Class II school and is accredited by the NDE. The school is a member of the Southern Nebraska Conference, and the district is governed by a six-member Board of Education. The Sutton High School offers many upper-level subjects including American Literature, College English, Trigonometry, Calculus, Advanced Biology, Chemistry, and Physics. Sutton Jr./Sr. High School has also developed a Career Pathway program for its students. The high school offers appropriate college prep classes and multiple extra-curricular activities. Opportunities for students to expand their knowledge in the agricultural and business sector occur as the students are active members of the community. Sutton Elementary School places a strong emphasis in the areas of reading and writing and places a strong emphasis in the areas of literacy and math instruction. The community shows strong support for the school.

Sutton is located 30 miles southwest of York and 50 miles southeast of Grand Island. Sutton sits on the Ogallala Aquifer and is strategically located between Interstate 80 and US Highway 81. Sutton is a community of approximately 1,500 with a rich history dating all the way back to 1871. There are many residents of Sutton whose family trees follow the roots of the community, and who can proudly claim ancestral connections to the men and women who shaped the community.

The City of Sutton promotes economic development and growth of the community through the Sutton Community Redevelopment Authority and the Sutton Housing Authority. Sutton has a Community Center, Golf Course, Aquatic Facility, Museum, Ball Park, Pond, City Park and the Allegro Wolf Arts Center. City of Sutton holds a community Easter Egg Hunt, Dugout Days in June, Career Exploration Day, and the Parade of Lights in December.
