The school district covers approximately 200 square miles and encompasses the communities of Falls City, Rulo, Salem, Preston, Barada, and Verdon. There districts includes five buildings, all located in Falls City. The schools include the High School (9-12), Middle School (6-8), South Elementary School (3-5), North Elementary School (PreK-2), and the Sixpence/Alternative School. FCPS operates Early Childhood Programs for ages Birth-3 and 3-4. A unique educational opportunity for students in the Falls City area is the newly opened Career Academy. This partnership is between Southeast Community College (SENCAP) and several schools in the area. There are five programs in the career pathways of Agriculture, Construction, Education, Healthcare and Welding.

Falls City is located in the extreme southeast corner of Nebraska, a prime location, strategically placed at the center of America's heartland. There are multiple major metropolitan areas less than two hours away: Kansas City, Topeka, Lincoln and Omaha. Falls City has a population of 4,671 and is recognized for its annual festivals, history, and natural beauty.
